
Aims and Philosophies

Introduction

GOM-YES was established in year 2009, in the fond memory of late Mrs. Gomati Devi (1940-1980), our 'Lady of Vision' who very soon in her life, recognized the value of education, honesty & hard work in one's life & character! She considered them essential for one's success and well-being. She instilled these values in her children too, apart from insisting everyone in her circle to help & support young pupils in pursuing quality higher education, so that they may enrich themselves by fetching knowledge and emancipating their lives by using it aptiv.

GDM-YES is run under the aegis of Gomati Devi Smriti Shakcharik Samiti (GDSSS Trust), Lalganj, Azamgarh.

Every year, 14th May is celebrated as GDM-YES Foundation Day (since 2009) as the 'Unison of Visionaries' Day'!

We're a Co-educational English Medium School, based on CBSE pattern, for Students from Play-Group/ Nursery to Kinder-Garten as well as Class I to X.

We have a lush-green school campus spread in an area of more than 2.5 acres in Gomati Nagar, (on the way to Tarwan -0.5 Km from Lalganj Market) in Lalganj, Azamgarh.

Our Strength lies in our 'Simple Philosophies of Work and Life'. We feel - 'Education is the biggest treasure that seldom gets deteriorated, lost or stolen.'

Our Assets - are 'Our People'. We have a dedicated team of highly qualified and efficient Teachers and other Staff Members with a focused Top Management Support. Currently, we have a large number of students base, along with 60+ Teaching and 35+ Non-Teaching Staff.

We owe our students - the same comfort and security as that like of a 'Second-Home'. Our main motive is an all-round development of our students, so we use innovative techniques of teaching as to make learning a fun.









School Pacilities

INFRASTRUCTURE & AMENITIES

We have one of the finest 'Learning-hubs' for students in the vicinity.

We have two lush-green campuses spread over a sprawling area of above 2.5 acres with 3 Buildings, viz., an Administrative-Block and two Academic-Blocks- an each for Junior- and Senior-level Students, respectively.

We have 50+ Classrooms with a big Assembly-cum-Play Ground, a well-equipped Ulbrary and Computer Lab. We are equipped with HCL and MBD Digi-classes as an Advanced Learning Platform for kids of all levels. Projector-based studies are basic medium of teaching to make curriculum more interesting and easy to grasp!

We've Science Laboratories (PCB) and other Skill-Labs (Maths, Computers, Arts & Crafts, English Speaking, Music & Dance, Project Rooms, etc.) too.

We also have an Auditorium for Cultural Activities and a Play-House for Little-ones furnished with all kind of toys, games and Audio/Visual Systems for learning and entertainment.

We have 'Portable Drinking Water' and good Sanitation Facilities, We have the 'Students'-Emporium', 'Staff-Room', 'Waiting-Room', 'Fee-Office' and 'Principal Room' in Administrative Block, separately operating outside the Academic Block, as to ascertain minimum disturbances in Studies.

We provide Transport Facility too, on all major routes to fetch Students from distant areas. We have a fleet of 6 big and 20 minibuses, along with several motorized and non-motorized carriages for 'pick-up and drop' facility.





FACULTY PROFILE TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Our pedagogy is best in the region in terms of Knowledge-delivery.

We've a team of 60+ highly qualified and trained teaching staff. Our teachers are trained to impart learning to our students aided by various teaching tools & techniques.

We implement best teaching practices and norms to establish benchmarks in quality education.

We encourage our teachers to use various audio/visual aids and to supplement easy learning by flash-cards, charts, posters, figurines, toys, games, models, diagrams, etc.

Rules & Regulations

School Decorum

- Our School Timings are 7:50 am to 1:30 pm in summers while 8:50 am to 2:30 pm in winters. All students are
 expected to reach school before Assembly-congregation at 8:00/9:00 am respectively.
- Attendance in school is compulsory on the opening day of each term.
- Irregular attendance, unjustified absence for long or objectionable moral behavior justify dismissal. If a student is absent for three consecutive days in a term without an application his/her name may be struck off the rolls.
- All the absentees from school must bring with them a leave application from the parent/guardian.
- . In case of illness, a medical certificate must be produced within three days of absence.
- School Dress
- Our School Dress Code is White Shirt, Carbon Blue Pants (for Boys) and Carbon Blue Tunics/ Skirts (for Girls), Striped Tie & Belt, Navy Blue Socks, Black Shoes and White Hanker-chiefs.
- . White Pants/Skirts in Dress are meant for Activity/PT/Sports Days.
- . Winter Uniform consists of Maroon Blazers/Pullovers, Dark Blue Stockings/ Slex/ Leg-ins and Maroon Mufflers/Scarps too.
- No additional accessories/ wear-ables are allowed for Boys/ Girls like Casual Clothes, Caps, Head-Gears, Hand-bands, Nosepins, Bracelets/Anklets, etc apart from prescribed dress-code.
 - Boys are advised to keep their hair short while Girls are encouraged to keep hair tied neatly in two-plaits or tied by bands.
- . All the students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. They are expected to come in uniform every day.

EXPECTED FROM STUDENTS

- Students should obey their Parents, Teachers and elders with all regard and respect.
- All students are required to abide by rules & regulations of school to maintain dignity and integrity of themselves, their school, their teachers as well as their parents
- Students should follow whatever they are taught in class and help their fellow-mates too.
- 4. Students should also take care of their personal belongings to avoid loss by theft.
- All the students are expected to line up in silence for the assembly and should disperse in silence to their classes.
- 6. Proper discipline must be maintained in between periods.
 - Students will not be allowed to leave the school during school hours.
- . No books, other than the required text books should be brought to school.
- 9. Any damage to school property will have to be made good. The decision of the Principal regarding the amount will be final.
- The school will not be responsible for any loss of books, money, clothes, bicycles etc. Students are not allowed to bring valuable articles to the school.
- He/She must communicate with the teacher, friends and others in English which is the medium of instruction. A satisfactory
 conduct is necessary for a child to be considered for promotion to the next class.
- 13. Student must come to school with the lessons well prepared and the homework completed.
- 14. Running, playing and shouting inside the school premises is not allowed.

Expected from Parents/ Guardians

- Parents are advised to send their ward(s) neat & clean, in proper uniforms; with all Text-books and Note-books in their Bags according to the Weekly Time-Table; and help them reach School timely.
- Parents are advised to give students only home-cooked food in Lunch-boxes and clean drinking water in Water-Bottles. Kids should not be given money, etc. or should be encouraged to buy and eat outside/junk food.
- Parents are advised to regularly check the Diaries of their wards for HW/ Notices/ Updates/ Remarks from Teachers/ School and also actively enjoin in Parents-Teachers' Meetings held in School from time—to-time, to be aware of their wards' progress.
- Parents are requested to make all Fees-related Payments timely, to avoid any hassle/ late Fees-Fines. Kindiy avoid sending money with your child and try making regular payments (Tultion Fees, Transport Fees, Computer/Science Lab Fees, Exam Fees, etc.) by personally visiting the Fees-counter in Office Hours only, Also, never forget to collect and retain the duly signed recommendation the School Forgour further records.



School Activities & Achievements

Curriculum

Our curriculum is based on the syllabus prescribed by Central Board for Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, Medium of Instruction is English. It includes Subjects like English, Hindi, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Computer Science, Moral Science, Sanskrit, Arts & Craft, Games, Music, Dance, Physical Education and Environmental Education.

However, we believe firmly that education does not come with textbooks rather we have to fine- tune young minds to grow a natural inquistiveness towards enquiry, research, logical-thinking and conclusion so as to heighten their spirit of true knowledge-seeking venture.

We provide extra care and attention to weaker students.

Extra-curricular Activities

We encourage our students to take part in various Co-curricular activities, so as to hone their creative abilities and other soft-skills too. We organize Cultural Programmes on National Days like 26th January, 15th August, and 2nd October as well as on Teacher's Day, Children's Day, etc. We celebrate our Foundation-Day on 14th May every year. The 'Annual Soorts Day's forgranized on 14" November each wear.

We also appreciate our students in enjoying festivals like Holi, Diwali, Eid, Rakshabandhan, Christmas, etc.; so, as to breed the feeling of unity and brotherhood among them. Quizzes and Elocutions are organized in Classes. Rangoli, Mehndi, Drawing & Crafts Competitions are also organized from time to time.

We also put our students into physical exercises like PT, Yoga, Sports, etc. to keep them fit. We also take our students to Educational Tours/ Excursions to Historically and Culturally important Destinations like Varanasi, Allahabad, etc.

We arrange intra-school students' activities under Four House Systems-viz. RED, GREEN, BLUE& YELLOW House. We also encourage our Students to take part in various Interschool Competitions.
